

ENGLISH

As of January 10, 2023, the announcements made by U.S. Government officials and the forms referred to indicate the following will be required when applying for the new Humanitarian Parole program that President Biden announced on January 6, 2023.

There are many things that Supporters (people in the United States) will need to start collecting and doing. There are also a few things that Beneficiaries (the person or people outside of the United States) will need to start collecting and doing as well.

The list below is not complete because every other day or so there is new information about this program. But one thing is certain, the documents and steps listed below are necessary in order to start the process. Please keep in mind that additional details may be added in the weeks and months to come.

SUPPORTERS

Now, first thing for people in the United States (the Supporters) to do for people outside of the United States (Beneficiaries):

- The Supporters need to gather three years of income tax. Now, we are talking about income tax files for 2019, 2020, 2021. But If the supporters wait to file the application after February when all the 2022 income tax papers are ready, the Supporters will have to submit income tax records for 2020, 2021, 2022. I am talking about Form 1040. But if the tax preparers filed the Supporters income tax with any additional forms, we will need copies of all those forms that you sent to IRS. We will also need all W-2s of yourself and of your spouse.
- If you have money in the bank or other types of investments, we will need the 1099 forms for all those three years of income tax.
- We will need from each adult in your household a letter from their banks(s), signed by an officer of the bank. This letter should include the exact following information (otherwise, Immigration might deny the application, and if the Immigration rejects this application, there is no chance to start it again):
 1. The date your account was opened – and if you have more than one account, the date each account was opened.
 2. The total deposits made to the account(s) for the last 12 months
 3. The current balance of the account(s)

MOUN SIPO

Kounye a, premye bagay pou moun Ozetazini (Sipòtè yo) fè pou moun ki andeyò Etazini (Benefisyè):

- Sipòtè yo bezwen rasanble twazan taks sou revni. Kounye a, n ap pale de dosye taks sou revni pou ane 2019, 2020, 2021. Men, si sipòtè yo ap tann pou yo ranpli aplikasyon an apre fevriye lè tout papye taks sou revni 2022 yo pare, Sipòtè yo ap oblije soumèt dosye taks sou revni pou ane 2020, 2021, 2022. M ap pale de Fòm 1040. Men, si moun k ap prepare taks yo te ranpli taks sou revni Supporters ak nenpòt fòm adisyonèl, n ap bezwen kopi tout fòm sa yo ou te voye bay IRS. N ap bezwen tou tout W-2 ou menm ak mari oswa madanm ou.
- Si w gen lajan nan bank la oswa lòt kalite envestisman, n ap bezwen fòm 1099 yo pou tout twa ane taks sou revni sa yo.
- Nou pral bezwen chak adilt lakay ou yon lèt ki soti nan bank yo, ki siyen pa yon ofisye nan bank la. Lèt sa a ta dwe gen ladann enfòmasyon egzak sa yo (otremman, Imigrasyon ta ka refize aplikasyon an, epi si Imigrasyon an rejte aplikasyon sa a, pa gen okenn chans pou yo kòmanse li ankò):
 1. Dat yo te ouvri kont ou a - epi si ou gen plis pase yon kont, dat yo te louvri chak kont.
 2. Total depo yo te fè nan kont (yo) pou 12 dènye mwa yo
 3. Balans aktyèl kont la (yo)

The application requires that the Sponsors provide employment verification such as:

- Pay stubs for the month prior to the application AND
- An employment letter from the Sponsor's employers. Immigration has specific guidelines about the content of the employment verification letter. This letter must state the following:
 1. Date hired
 2. Your position
 3. Your salary
 4. If the position is temporary or permanent

If the employment letter doesn't provide all the required information, Immigration might deny the application.

If you have investments, if you own stocks, bonds, mutual funds, you will need to provide proof of them.

If you own real estate, if you own a house, you will need to:

1. go to City Hall to obtain a signed and sealed copy of the title
2. Provide mortgage statement for each mortgage you have on the house (statement must say how much is the mortgage. If you have two mortgages; you must provide a statement for each mortgage.
3. Finally, you – the Supporter – will need an appraisal of your property. Have the house appraised. I know appraisals cost a lot, but I know a real estate agent in Norwalk, Connecticut - Guy Bocicaut – who can appraise Connecticut properties at a very affordable price. Guy Bocicaut has been providing such estimates for a long time in the area and banks, mortgage companies and attorney's accept his estimates. However, Guy Bocicaut can only serve you if your property is in Connecticut.

The Supporters must prove their legal status:

- U.S. citizens and nationals;
- Lawful permanent residents, lawful temporary residents, and conditional permanent residents;
- Non-immigrants in lawful status (who maintain their nonimmigrant status and have not violated any of the terms or conditions of their nonimmigrant status);
- Asylees, refugees, and parolees;
- Individuals granted Temporary Protected Status (TPS); or Beneficiaries of deferred action (including deferred action for childhood arrivals) or DED.

Everyone in the household of the supporter is requested to provide all of the same documentation.

Si lèt travay la pa bay tout enfòmasyon ki nesèsè yo, Imigrasyon ka refize aplikasyon an.

Si ou gen envèstisman, si ou posede aksyon, obligasyon, fon mityèl, w ap bezwen bay prèv yo.

Si w posede byen imobilye, si w posede yon kay, w ap bezwen:

1. ale nan City Hall pou jwenn yon kopi tit la siyen epi sele
2. Bay deklarasyon ipotèk pou chak ipotèk ou genyen sou kay la (deklarasyon dwe di konbyen ipotèk la. Mwen ou gen de ipotèk; ou dwe bay yon deklarasyon pou chak ipotèk.
3. Finalman, ou menm – Sipòtè a – ap bezwen yon evalyasyon sou pwopriyete w la. Fè kay la evalye. Mwen konnen evalyasyon yo koute anpil, men mwen konnen yon ajan byen imobilye nan Norwalk, Connecticut - Guy Bocicaut - ki ka evalye pwopriyete Connecticut a yon pri trè abòdab. Guy Bocicaut ap bay estimasyon sa yo depi lontan nan zòn nan ak bank, konpayi ipotèk ak avoka aksepte estimasyon li yo. Sepandan, Guy Bocicaut ka sèvi ou sèlman si pwopriyete w la nan Connecticut.

Sipòtè yo dwe pwouve estati legal yo:

- Sitwayen ak sitwayen ameriken;
- Rezidan pèmanan legal, rezidan tanporè legal, ak rezidan pèmanan kondisyonèl;
- Non-imigran ki nan sitiyasyon legal (ki kenbe estati non-imigran yo epi ki pa vyole okenn nan tèm oswa kondisyon estati non-imigran yo);
- Azilye, refijye, ak pwovizwa;
- Moun ki resevwa Estati Pwoteje Tanporè (TPS); oswa Benefisyè aksyon difere (ki gen ladan aksyon difere pou arive timoun) oswa DED.

<p>There is a form that the supporter is required to file online. It requires a lot of information. In case of any mistake, Immigration may deny the application and they might not allow you to apply again.</p> <p>On the application form, they ask many difficult questions such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - “When the beneficiary arrives, what are you going to do to find them a place to live, pay for their housing and food until they find work. And if they can’t find work, what are you going to do to support them?”. - “If they need medical treatment and/or medication, what are you going to do to help them?” <p>and many more. You need to be ready to answer these questions persuasively.</p> <p>This is the initial list of things the Supporter – the person based in United States – will need to start working on. <p><u>BENEFICIARIES</u></p> <p>After that, there are several things that the people outside of the United States will need to start working on as well. Here is a partial list of these things, the things they should start to collect immediately:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Must have a valid passport.
